備註說明：

1. 最低畢業學分為128學分，其中包括校定必修28學分(包含通識12學分)，系必修52學分、選修48學分(本系專業選修至少28學分)。
2. 依本校學則規定，大學部學生需通過「英語能力」、「資訊能力」、「中文能力」、「運動能力」及「專業基本能力」檢定，始得畢業。
3. 本系大學部學生應於在學期間「通過畢業專題設計報告書審核，並公開創作作品發表及通過審查」，並於「畢業前至少參加國內外重大設計競賽乙次(作品須經指導老師同意)」，始得畢業。
4. 通識課程校定必修的12學分中，學生須於「人文」、「社會」、「自然」三大領域核心課程(必選各2學分)，及新設「跨領域探索與自主學習」領域中跨領域探索課群課程(必選3學分)，各選修一門，共計4門課，累計9學分。另須於「人文」、「社會」、「自然」三大領域之延伸課程，及「跨領域探索與自主學習領域」之自主學習課程，選擇2個課程，且不能集中同一領域，合計至少3學分。
5. 鼓勵學生多元跨域學習，凡修習校內其他系所課程、「跨領域學分學程」或「教育學程」課程，均可列入系選修畢業學分；惟選修體育課程之採認以4學分為限，且選修通識課程(必修12學分以外)不列入本系選修畢業學分，本項規定可追溯115學年度(含)以前入學學生適用。
6. 重補修必修課程得經系主任同意修習他系同性質課程，並以選修補足所需學分，可追溯115學年度(含)以前入學學生適用。
7. 本必選修科目表之選修課程，可追溯115學年度(含)以前入學學生適用。
8. 應屆畢業生及延修生若因體育必修課程未通過得以綜合體育一、綜合體育二對抵，至多對抵兩門體育必修課程，該課程對抵可追溯至109學年度以前入學學生適用。

1. Students need to complete 128 course credits to be eligible for graduation, which includes 28 university-required course credits (including 12 General Education course credits), 52 department-required course credits and 48 elective course credits. (at least 28 professional elective course credits within the department) 2. In accordance with the General Provisions for Study, undergraduate students need to meet the university-wide basic competencies of English, Information Technology, Chinese, and Sports, and pass the core competencies of their department to be eligible for graduation. 3. To be eligible for graduation, undergraduate students need to pass the Graduation Project Design report evaluation, as well as to publicly exhibit and pass the review of their innovative works during their study. In addition, they must participate in at least one major design competition – upon approval of their advisor – domestically or abroad before graduation. 4. Among the 12 university-designated required General Education credits, students must take one course from the Core Courses in the three areas: " Humanities," " Social Sciences," and " Natural Sciences " (2 credits each), and one course from the Interdisciplinary Exploration course group in the newly established " Interdisciplinary Exploration and Self-directed study" area (3 credits). In total, students must take 4 courses. and accumulating 9 credits. Students must select 2 elective courses from the Extended Courses in the " Humanities," " Social Sciences," and " Natural Sciences " areas, and the self-directed study courses under the “Interdisciplinary Exploration and Self-directed study” area. These 2 courses must not be from the same area, and at least 3 credits in total. 5. To encourage interdisciplinary learning, credits earned from courses outside the department, including those from other academic departments, Interdisciplinary Credit Programs, or the Teacher Education Program, can be counted toward departmental elective graduation credits. However, this is subject to the following restrictions: elective Physical Education courses are capped at a maximum of 4 credits, and elective General Education courses (excluding the 12 required credits) are strictly excluded from departmental elective credits. This regulation applies retroactively to students enrolled prior to the 2026-27 academic year. 6. Students may take retake course of the same mandatory from other department, if approved by the department chair. It can be applied retroactively to students enrolled prior to the 2026-27 academic year. 7. The elective courses listed in this curriculum framework are applicable to students enrolled prior to the 2026-27 academic year. 8. Graduating students and students in the extended study period who did not pass required courses of Physical Education can waive a maximum of two (2) required Physical Education courses by passing Comprehensive Physical Education I, Comprehensive Physical Education II. This regulation is applicable for those admitted in and prior to 2020-21 academic year. 9. Foreign students, overseas Chinese students, Hong Kong students and Macao students may select the following courses to waive “Chinese Literature: Appreciation and Creative Writing I and II” once the related test confirms that they have insufficient Chinese ability: “Basic Mandarin I and II” or “Chinese Literature I and II”. This may also be retroactively applied to students who entered the university prior to the 2023-24 academic year.
